for the

Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English)

Date of the Competition: October 7, 2025 Time: 09:00 a.m. Venue: Vidyapeeth Vidyarthi Bhavan, Churchgate, Mumbai

Eligibility

- A full time bonafide students of the affiliated college / recognized institute and academic department of the University of Mumbai is eligible to participate in the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English).
- The age of the student shall not exceed 25 years as on September 30, 2025.

Participation

- Each affiliated college / recognized institute and academic department of the University of Mumbai may nominate only one student to participate in the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English).
- The nomination must be duly forwarded by the Principal / Director / Head of the affiliated college / recognized institute / University academic department.
- No entry fee shall be charged for the competition.

Procedure of the Competition

- The topic for the competition shall be given on the spot.
- Each participant will assigned one topic out of five on a lottery basis.
- A preparation time of 30 minutes will be given prior to the presentation.
- Each participant will be allotted 5 minutes to speak. A warning bell will be given after 4 minutes.
- The order of participants will be arranged through lottery basis.
- The decision of the judges shall be final.

Expenses

All expenses related to travel of the participants for the Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate
Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English) shall be borne by the affiliated college /
recognized institute / University academic department.

Awards and Certificates

- The Winner (First Rank) of Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-Collegiate Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English) will be nominated to represent the University of Mumbai in the Maharashtra State Chancellor P.C. Alexander Inter-University Extempore Elocution Competition (Medium: English).
- All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation on the day of the competition.
- The participants securing First Rank, Second Rank, Third Rank and Consolation will be awarded a Certificate of Merit on the day of the competition.
